



Portfolio

Portfolio is one of three gatekeeping processes (along with the Comprehensive Exam) by which the DOGC faculty determines student readiness to graduate from the CMHC program. Students must register to present their Portfolio prior to graduation during the Advanced Internship course. In addition to completing all Portfolio requirements, students must present a professional case conceptualization of a client with whom they have worked during the Advanced Internship course. Portfolio is a “Pass/Fail” component of the CMHC degree. Students receiving a passing grade will be eligible for graduation from the CMHC program. Students receiving a failing grade will be required to complete remedial work as designated by faculty. If a student fails Portfolio twice but has shown competency in all areas of the Portfolio assessment, the student should meet with their advisor and the department chair to assess alternative methods of meeting the Portfolio requirement.
