## Proposed program changes 2022-2023

The faculty have reviewed assessment data from 2021-2022 and made recommendations for program changes. The advisory board met in September 2022 to review assessment data and offer recommendations as well. The following are proposed changes for the 2022-2023 academic year.

- The department will establish a goal of 85% of students passing key performance indicators per course.
- The department will discuss with the admissions team continued strategies for reaching diverse applicants.
- The department will continue to revise the student self-evaluation process to better target the developmental level of each cohort.
- The faculty will adapt all courses from Moodle to Canvas in 2022-2023.
- The department will develop a Chi Sigma Iota chapter by August 2023.
- The department will consider new ways that students can engage with professional organizations.
- The department will engage in a faculty search to add a new faculty member to the department by August 2023.
