Proposed program changes 2023-2024

The faculty have reviewed assessment data from 2022-2023 and made recommendations for program changes. The advisory board met in Fall 2023 to review assessment data and offer recommendations as well. The following are proposed changes for the 2023-2024 academic year.

- The faculty determined that the employer survey and alumni survey, which are each given bi-annually, are helpful tools, but not accurate reflections of current program outcomes, so these measures were removed from the overall annual program evaluation summary.
- The faculty will utilize a curriculum assessment rubric to evaluate course content and prepare for the new 2024 CACREP Standards.
- The faculty will evaluate a new syllabus template to streamline the information provided in each department syllabus.
- The department will review potential software to integrate with Canvas for better assessment tools, particularly for disposition assessment and key performance indicator charting.
- The administration will evaluate the potential need for a new faculty position due to growth in the Department of Graduate Counseling.
- The department will complete a needs assessment and consider the impact of an additional specialization track in graduate counseling.
- The faculty will develop and utilize a faith integration rubric to assess how consistently each course is meeting the program learning outcome for faith integration.
