To be eligible to participate in a Transition to Teaching program in secondary education within the state of Indiana, applicants must meet <u>one</u> of these four conditions:

- 1. Bachelor's degree in subject area or related field in which thecandidate wants to teach and an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher from accredited institution
- 1. Bachelor's degree in subject area or related field in which the candidate wants to teach with 2.5 GPA from accredited institution
- 2. 5 years of <u>relevant</u> professional experience
- 1. Bachelor's degree from accredited institution
- 2. Proof of passing state approved secondary content area assessment in the subject area the candidate wants to teach
- 1. Graduate degree insubject area or related field in which the candidate wants to teach
